

WINTER HOOPS CLASSIC TOURNAMENT RULES

All NFHS (Oregon) rules apply will following modifications:

- Two 16-minute stop-clock halves; If in 2nd half differential is 20 points or more, clock runs except for timeouts.
- 1st overtime period is 2-minutes, stop-clock.
- 2nd overtime is un-timed. First team scoring 3 points wins. Championship Final only: 2nd and successive OT is 2-minutes, stop clock.
- Three full timeouts per game; one full time-out per OT, no carry-over.
- 5-minute half times & 5-minute warm up period between games
- A team up by 20 points or more is not allowed to play full court defense.
- For 5th Grade Divisions and under- man to man only, this rule is included in the full court setting. No zone defense, but switching is allowed. Once the ball is attacking the basket (inside 3-pt line) and/or entered into post, players may slide over to help however must revert back to their man if the ball is reset out beyond 3-pt line.
- Pool Tie-Breakers:
 - 1) Head-to-Head
 - 2) Greatest Average Point Differential (max 15 per game)
 - 3) Least cumulative points allowed
- Unsportsmanlike technical fouls will result in the opposing team receiving two points and possession of the ball; player receiving technical must sit out next 2 minutes of play.
- Any coach, player or fan that receives 2 technical fouls in any one game will be removed from that game and the remainder of the tournament.
- Any team receiving three technical fouls will result in a forfeit of that game.
- Champion T-shirts will be awarded to each 1st Place team
